Food Service Milk Bid 2016-2017

- LOWFAT MILK- ½ pints, must contain no less than 0.5 or more than 1.0% milk fat per unit
- FLAVORED MILK (fat free only)- ½ pint, must contain no more than 0.5 milk fat per unit
- SKIM MILK- ½ pint, must contain no more than 0.5 milk fat per unit
- Milk must be delivered in sealed, leak proof, ½ pint containers which are clean and sterile.
- Successful bidder will furnish and maintain in good repair automatic refrigeration units with locks, where specified. Units shall be reasonably free of dirt and grease. No greater than a five day supply of milk will be accepted at any of the five schools.
- Prices quoted must include transportation and delivery charges fully paid by the contractor. Each delivery must have a receiving slip stating the description of each item and quantity delivered.
- All out of date and unused milk is to be collected by the vendor and noted on credit invoices.
- All delivery arrangements will be coordinated with and approved by the Food Service Director.
- All items furnished under this bid shall be identified as having been officially inspected for wholesomeness and sanitation under Federal or State regulatory program. All items must comply with Federal and Illinois State laws.
- In the event the successful bidder is unable to fulfill any of the stated requirements, contract is subject to immediate cancellation. Additionally, the Board of Education reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time for due cause including, but not limited to, such reasons as unsatisfactory products or service.

Sealed bids are due in the Genoa-Kingston Office (980 Park Avenue, Genoa, IL 60135) by 9:15 am on Thursday, June 16 and will be opened in the Community Room of Genoa-Kingston High School at that time.
