Children will have fun learning about nature through hands-on activities, games, and nature awareness. Camps fill quickly and space is limited to 20 children per camp so register now!

June 18-22 Pioneer Camp (ages 7-9)



Come back in time with us. We will experience the life of pioneer kids. We will make candles, cook food in a Dutch oven, play pioneer games and much more! Campers will get to make decisions during a simulated wagon train activity. No need to head west, just come to camp with us!

June 25-29 Naturalist Adventure Camp (ages 9-11)

July 9-13 Rainforest Camp (ages 7-9)

July 23-27 Critter Camp (ages 7-9)



To discover the secrets of the forest you have to look very closely and be very sneaky! Hike and explore the forest to learn about animals, plants and how they are all connected. We will observe and learn from the forest creatures and play like they do, too!

July 30-Aug 3 Rockin' in the River Camp (ages 9-11)



Kids, you never get tired of this one. This entire camp is dedicated to the Kishwaukee River and all the creatures that live in and around it. We will study, play and become river experts by the end of this week. Campers will have a wild and wet week of learning and fun. **(Close-toed shoes that can be worn into the river are required. No flip-flops or slides!)**
