What is PBIS?

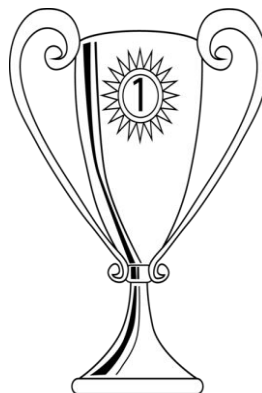
PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention System) is a behavior intervention program implemented school wide at Genoa Elementary.
