Tricky Words

Definition: Tricky (*sight*) words

are words that are immediately recognizable.

Tricky Word Facts:

- **Tricky words are the most frequently used words in the English language.
- **Tricky words make up about 50% of any written text.
- **Students will be able to read more fluently if they have learned to recognize tricky words instantly and automatically.
- **Some tricky words can not be decoded or "sounded out".

This year we will focus mainly on tricky words that can not be sounded out and must be memorized. Practice at home will be beneficial for your child's literacy development.
