



Kindergarten, First & Second Shuttle Bus Schedule 2017-18

All Kind, 1st & 2nd grade students living within the city limits of Genoa will be transported by bus to and from Kingston School each day.

1. Those students living on the **north side** of town (North of Route 72) will be picked up and dropped off at Genoa Middle School
2. Students living on the **south side** of town (South of Route 72) will be picked up and dropped off at Genoa Elementary School on Hill St.

Please have your child **report only** to his or her assigned school as listed above. The students should be at their designated school no earlier than 7:45 a.m. **All buses will leave for Kingston Elementary School at 7:50 a.m.** Students will be returned to these same schools at approximately 3:05 p.m.

High School Students Residing within the city limits of Genoa (except for Willow Glen Subdivision including Stone Creek, Forest View Manor, and River Bend Sub – bus service not provided)

High School students wishing to ride a bus to the High School each day are to report to one of the following schools:

Genoa Middle School, 940 W. Main St. by 7:25 a.m. and board Bus 27 when it arrives or

Genoa Elementary School, 602 W. Hill St. by 7:30 a.m. and board Bus 5 or 27 when they arrive

At dismissal each day the following buses will be loading immediately at the High School and return to:
Genoa Middle School – Bus 5 or 27
Genoa Elementary School – Bus 27

Notice to All Students:

Letters have been mailed to all rural students affected by any significant route changes. Route information for Willow Glen, Forest View Manor, Oak Creek, Riverbend, Windhaven & in town Kingston is available online. Please read all transportation information carefully, making sure you understand all necessary changes that have been made.
